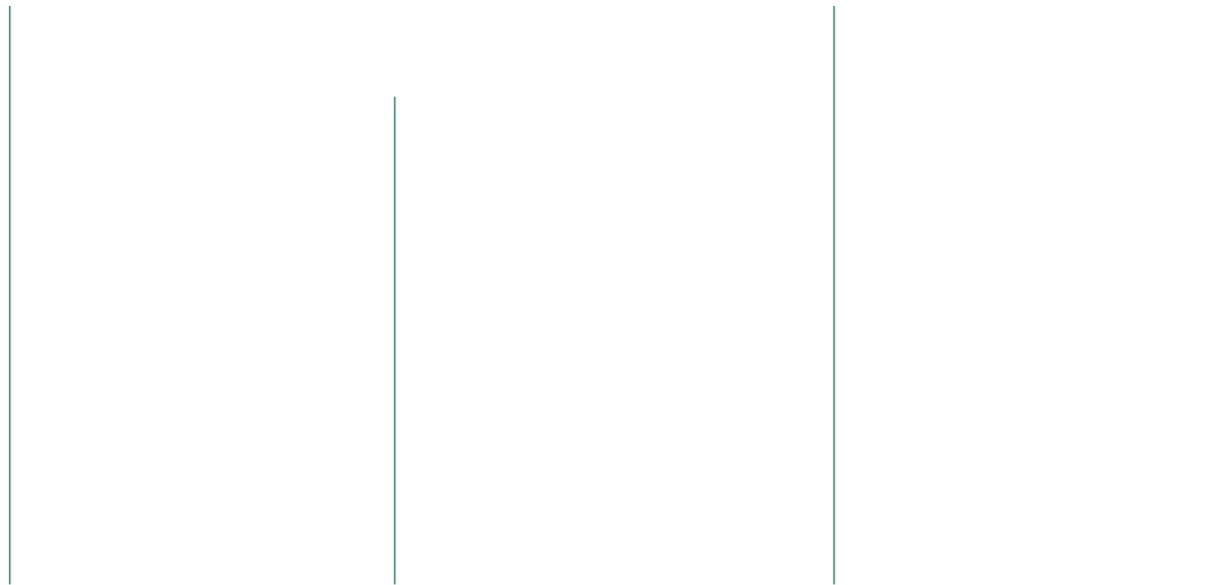

Consolidating the definition of sustainability for the world of wine is one of the key missions of the Sustainable Wine Roundtable.



E&C are incredibly proud to be Founding Members of the Sustainable Wine Roundtable since 2021. We actively support regular discussions and contribute to the SWR's work. As the SWR is conducting its extensive review of international standards of sustainability in wine, in the meantime, E&C has crystallised its approach to sustainability around three key pillars.

The Sustainable Wine Roundtable is the only global, independent, not-for-profit multi-stakeholder roundtable, designed to incorporate the whole wine value chain. One of their key goals is consolidating the myriad definitions of sustainability around the world of wine with one clear and consistent definition. E&C Operational Sustainability Overview

At the beginning of 2022, we formed an inter-departmental Sustainability Taskforce that meets monthly to report on progress against our sustainability goals. We have switched our warehouse and head office to an energy provider who provides 100% renewable source electricity



Paper Use

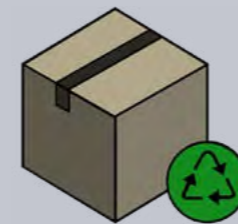
In 2020, we switched to a fully digital wine list, and any professionally printed collateral is now printed on Forest Stewardship Council-certified paper; the number of pages printed in-house decreased by 65% from January-June 2019 to the same period in 2022



Waste

Packaging

100% of our boxes and inner packaging is recyclable, biodegradable and compostable, and we are working towards sourcing all paper and board materials from certified, sustainably managed forests under the Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) and Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification (PEFC)



Importing

We are making strong progress with our carbon footprint through transport from our producers to our UK warehouse; for example, 90% of our Italian shipments are transported from the suppliers to our UK warehouse by rail, which reduces carbon dioxide emissions by 50% compared to traditional freight shipping

In September 2022, we introduced a brand-new energy and fuel-efficient fleet with brand-new vehicles across our nationwide distribution network

E&C Portfolio Sustainability Overview

In March 2022, we sent a survey out to all agency producers in our portfolio.

169 producers recieved this survey

45 questions in the survey

76% of producers replied to the survey

The questions in this survey gave our producers the oppertunity to tell us about their sustainability initiatives. These questionsranged over a wide number of topics including:

We analysed our producers' answers to this survey to produce the results of the Portfolio Sustainability Overview.

Country sustainability scores by category

In our analysis, we have differentiated between producer’s progress towards **environmental**, **social** or **governance** targets. We grouped together all producers from the same country, and calculated that country’s average score in each category.

We have weighted each of these three sections equally to calculate a producer’s overall score.

For country scores, we then calculated the average score across all producers from each country who responded to this survey.

Sustainable producers

Sustainability means meeting the needs of today's world without compromising the potential of the future to meet its needs.

In practice, this has not yet been legally defined. However, there is consensus it should incorporate respect for the environment, social responsibility and the accountability that comes with formal reporting and governance.

Some of the producers in this list hold legally recognised certifications that the practices they employ are sustainable, but others do not. We have compiled this list to recognise the range of innovative methods adopted by producers in the Enotria&Coe portfolio, and how they are driving change and progress.

Champagne

Gobillard

If you're after the true heart of Champagne, then look no further. The Gobillard family lives mere metres from the grave of Dom Pérignon, and following decades of hard work, have secured 26 hectares of vines, much of which is Premier Cru that was once owned by the Benedictine Hautvillers Abbey. A handful of carefully selected growers tend to a further 125 hectares nestled in the most prestigious crus, yielding a range of Champagnes that accentuate brightness, minerality and elegance over power and richness.

A small château in the Graves appellation of Bordeaux, Merlot-dominated where usually Cabernet Sauvignon is king, Château des Gravières makes wines that satisfy both the palate and the pocket. The Labuzan family, who continue to own and run the winery today, with brothers Thierry and Denis at the helm, are part of a long line of wine specialists, their first Labuzan vines being planted as far back as 1847.

Today, despite a continued focus on Merlot, the winery has expanded into growing Cabernet Sauvignon, Sémillon and Sauvignon Blanc varieties.

Colterenzio

The hamlet of Schreckbichl (Colterenzio in Italian) is situated amid cool, vine-covered rolling hills to the south of Bolzano. It forms part of South Tyrol's largest self-contained winegrowing area called Uberetsch, or 'beyond the Adige.' Formed in the 60s by a group of 28 winegrowers and estate owners, the co-operative has grown considerably over the years, and now has members supplying grapes from over 320 hectares of vineyards scattered throughout some of South Tyrol's finest sites.

Friuli-Venezia Giulia

Marco Felluga

The Felluga family has deep roots in the winemaking world of Istria back to the 19th century. One after another, generations of the Felluga family moved anti-clockwise around the peninsula in pursuit of a better wine market: first from Istria to the island of Grado, then further inland to Gradisca d'Isonzo. Today, Marco Felluga still works alongside his granddaughter Ilaria to create these benchmark wines in the Collio region. Following the untimely death of Ilaria's father, Roberto, in 2021, Ilaria is continuing his legacy, particularly as a pioneer of sustainability in the region.

Russiz Superiore

Having established his eponymous winery in 1956, Marco Felluga then noticed a nearby estate called Russiz Superiore in 1967. He was captivated by its 700-years' worth of history, and the incredible potential of the sites. The logo of Russiz Superiore is the double-headed eagle that was the emblem of the aristocratic Thurn-und-Taxis family that managed this estate for over seven centuries. These 50 hectares are on Italy's border with Slovenia, in the municipality of Capriva del Friuli, and effectively represent the Cru tier wines of the Marco Felluga winery.

Giovanni Puiatti

An innovator in his own right, Vittorio Puiatti developed what is now Italy's dominant winemaking technique for white wines, frequently called the "Metodo Puiatti." Only 100%stainless steel is used during both the fermentation and ageing of the wines. The winery is the first cellar in Friuli to be constructed using only steel, concrete and glass, reflecting his motto of 'Save a Tree, Drink Puiatti' – in other words, no oak is used in any of the wines.

Il Chiosso



In the dialect of Alto Piemonte, “il chiosso” refers to a vineyard that is enclosed by a stone wall, which demonstrates that the winemaker has identified the potential of this single site to create exceptional wines. That was precisely the mission of Marco Arlunno and Carlo Cambieri when they founded Il Chiosso in 2007. They both brought extensive winemaking experience in the region to the project: Marco as the producer of Ghemme, and Carlo as a vineyard owner and manager. In less than 15 years they have built up a reputation for Il Chiosso as one of the most compelling expressions of the Gattinara terroir, nurtured by a deeply traditional respect for nature.

We have selected two wines from Il Chiosso, which are Gattinara Galizja (their top cru) and Gattinara Riserva (which is only produced in exceptional vintages).

HOW IS IL CHIOSSO JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

Il Chiosso is deeply invested in learning and development opportunities for their staff. They have developed historic relationships with prestigious wineries, which gives their employees the opportunity to benefit from educational secondments, where they can broaden their knowledge and education by observing different techniques in action. Il Chiosso is a pillar of their community, as they support programmes for disadvantaged families through donations, and also a provincial initiative in partnership with the Italian Chamber of Commerce to improve accessibility of remote natural beauty spots.

Vistorta

Owned and operated since 1980 by Count Brandino Brandolini d'Adda, Vistorta is a 500-acre estate located in western Friuli-Venezia Giulia. With impressive winemaking investments in Bordeaux, Brandino has acquired the know-how, and entrepreneurial mentality, which he applies to his 40 acres of vineyard planted almost exclusively with Merlot. Brandolini is determined to produce the best Merlot in Italy, and constantly researches the best clones and planting systems to achieve this dream.

Fazi Battaglia

Fazi Battaglia prides itself on belonging to a brand that inherently conjures up an image of pure Italian identity and culture. Created in 1949 in a small cellar, the winery spent decades investing in improvements in the vineyards and focusing specifically on a single grape varietal, Verdicchio. These choices were far ahead of their time, and resulted in Fazi Battaglia's ascension to pioneers within the Marche, and the ultimate champions of Verdicchio within Italy.

This approach has already enabled them to switch from fuel-powered to hybrid vehicles across the estate with enormous support internally for the clearly calculated improvements in carbon footprint.

With a unique selection of Rieslings, including a non-alcoholic offering, Weingut Leitz is located in Rudesheim, at the western end of the Rheingau. This family estate is run by Johannes Leitz, who took over what was then a 2.6-hectare property from his mother in 1985, aged just 21. In 2011, he was named “Winemaker of the Year” by Gault Millau, Germany’s principal wine guide.

HOW IS LEITZ JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

Leitz have a highly data-driven approach to sustainability, where every head of department has clearly defined goals which they report against in regular meetings. They have found that this level of accountability and reporting has accelerated their progress, and has made sustainability a core pillar of working at this family-owned winery. Their key targets for the future are more efficient use of local water supply. They have monitored water use closely and noted improvements through drip irrigation and cover crops that boost nitrogen levels in the soil. They further plan to improve the efficiency of their drip irrigation systems by connecting to a reservoir that replenishes in the winter.

Leitz is currently applying for Fair 'n' Green, a German certification of sustainable viticulture, which they expect will be completed before the end of 2022.

Hattingley Valley



A family-owned business in the heart of Hampshire, Hattingley Valley have been winning international acclaim and awards ever since their first vintage in 2013. Their English wine project began in 2008 and has developed into a custom-built, eco-friendly winery, farming some 24 hectares of vines across two separate sites. The first winery in the UK to adopt solar power, Hattingley Valley is recognised as a top estate abroad, and looks to be gaining just as much recognition across its native land.

HOW IS HATTINGLEY JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

Hattingley aims to be Sustainable Wines of Great Britain certified by the end of 2022. To achieve this, their vineyards are 85% farmed according to organic practices with no herbicides, no insecticides, compost made on the Hattingley estate, cover crops and natural pest control with sheep grazing in the vineyards. Hattingley are working on installing beehives in the vineyards, as these pollinators will encourage flora biodiversity. The vineyards are surrounded by seven miles of hedgerow under a countryside stewardship scheme. They are currently trialling cellulose-based shrink wrap for pallets leaving the winery, and have installed double-sided under vine cultivators to reduce the number of tractor passes.

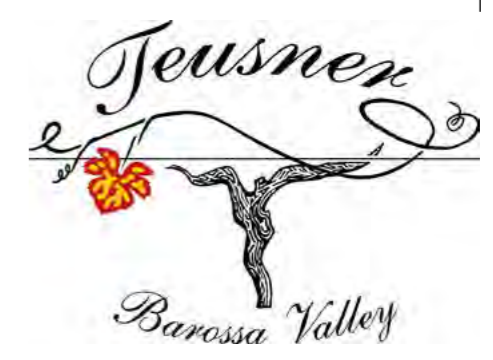

Portfolio Environmental Champion



When winemaker Kym Teusner overheard Barossa grape growers lamenting that they would have to rip out a plot of 85-year-old Grenache vines because they couldn't find a buyer to stump up the asking price, he knew he had to step in. At the time, he was still the winemaker at Torbreck, but he approached his brother-in-law, Michael Page, with a proposition to save as many of these vines as they could afford. The pair went into business, and produced their first vintage of The Joshua, a GSM blend, in 2002. The pair have gone from strength to strength, forging a reputation for working with Barossa growers to source old-vine fruit for elegant and complex wines.

In 2020, Teusner merged with Spanish-owned grower Terramoll, who have been investing in Barossa vines for over 20 years. This move gives Teusner access to 120 hectares of prime Barossa vines.

HOW IS TEUSNER JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

Teusner are piloting native grasses and self-seeding medics in one of their vineyards, which act as cover crops. The native grasses flourish in winter, while the medics follow in spring. Between them, they fix atmospheric nitrogen to boost soil structure and health, which in turn suppresses undesirable weeds and limits vulnerability to erosion from spring rains. Healthier soils also tend to need less ploughing, which reduces use of machinery. Teusner have sought out methods to reduce their waste load by transferring grape pomace to the neighbouring Tarac Technologies. Teusner has partnered with a local glass manufacturer that uses 80% recycled glass, with the added benefit of reduced carbon footprint from working with a local supplier.

Despite the challenges he faces, Marty couldn't shake off his love of wine, so he created a new winery, "Silver Lining" and declared the first vintage in 2020. Part of the profits from sales of these wines will be donated to Parkinson's Disease research in Australia, making the story and purpose behind these wines every bit as captivating as their quality.

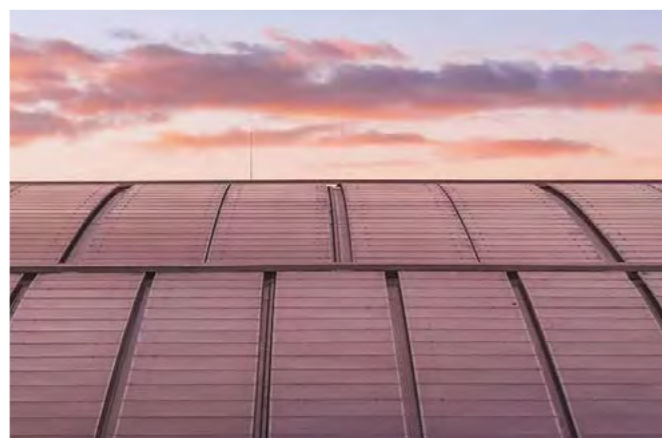

Overall Sustainability Champion



In 2008, Peter Yealands was inspired by the rugged and breath-taking coastline in this corner of Aotearoa Valley, Marlborough. The area had previously been thought to be too windswept for grapes to thrive, and too uneven for efficient vineyard management. Peter embraced the challenge and established a cutting-edge winery that embraces its incredible location to offer a unique sense of place and hospitality. Yealands is the world's first winery to be certified Toitū carbonzero since it was founded. The estate has now grown to over 1,000 hectares across the Aotearoa Valley, and today is in the hands of Natalie Christensen, named one of the World's Most Influential Women in Wine in 2018 by The Drinks Business.

HOW IS YEALANDS JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

Although 5% of Yealands vineyards are farmed organically, their core strategic focus is on reducing emissions. Their focus is on reducing use of diesel vehicles in the vineyards, and in their experience, the Yealands team have found that organic farming in their region requires higher tractor usage, making it more carbon intensive. In 2021, they completed the first phase of an ambitious creek restoration and riparian planting project to promote biodiversity. Solar panels on the roof of the winery provides 20% of their annual energy requirements. Waste water is treated at an on-site treatment facility. Overall, Yealands is working towards 5% annual emissions reduction year-on-year.

Man O' War

Man O' War is a stunning array of coastal hillsides with high cliffs and pristine beaches on the eastern end of Waiheke Island. Captain James Cook first sighted the rows of magnificent Kauri trees on this coastline on his first voyage around the islands of New Zealand, and noted they'd make ideal masts for the Navy's Man O' War battleships, hence the land gained its name.

Today, Man O' War is made up of 150 acres of vines planted in 76 individual hillside blocks, each with a distinct soil profile and microclimate. Winemaker Duncan McTavish ensures each small parcel of vines are carefully tended and harvested by hand, then vinified separately, fusing classic Old World techniques with innovative New World ideas to give his wines great intensity, depth, and personality.

These days Gyles is Cellar Master, with the talented Rudi Schultz responsible for the winemaking. However, the philosophy remains true to Gyles' original vision, centred on the principle of what he calls 'benign neglect' – minimal fining and filtration, and no use of commercial yeasts in the red wines.

Kleinood

The de Villiers family has left deep footprints in the history of the South African wine industry through the centuries, and Kleinood and the Tamboerskloof wines are no exception. The French Huguenot, Jacob de Villiers, bought the wine farm Boschendal between Stellenbosch and Franschhoek, after immigrating to the Cape of Good Hope in 1688. In the year 2000 Gerard de Villiers, a direct descendant of Jacob, and his wife, Libby, found the piece of land that stole their hearts – complete with mountains, river and a pristine tract of indigenous forest. Tamboerskloof is once again an integral part of the de Villiers family history as well as that of Cape Town and the Boland. The name Tamboerskloof means the valley (kloof) of the drums (tamboer).

HOW IS KLEINOOD JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

When the Kleinood team found out that some of their employees were living in informal settlements, they bought a plot of land 6km away from the estate and built four three-bedroom houses where they settled four employees together with their families.

Although Kleinood owns these houses, the employees only pay electricity bills or nominal rent. Many of Kleinood’s employees’ children go to a local school called Webersgedenk Primary School; in 2014, Kleinood built an Arts and Culture Centre for this school. To date, over 1,000 children have benefited from this facility, which is repurposed for adult evening classes.

During Covid lockdowns, the Kleinood team found out that a charity called Masikhule was struggling to fund basic meals for the children it supports. So far, they have donated R130,000 (roughly £6,500) to support this charity’s good work.

Peller Family Estates






When Hungarian-born Andrew Peller arrived in Canada in 1927, his dream was to persuade his new country to learn to love and appreciate fine wine as much as his fellow Europeans. After numerous setbacks and involvements in the brewing and newspaper industries – and with the financial help of his son Joe, by now a doctor – Peller Family Estates was finally born in 1969.

The Pellers are Icewine pioneers, being among the first families to explore the possibilities of this unique Canadian style of wine. But they went further, planting their Niagara Peninsula vineyards closer to Lake Ontario in an effort to make their Icewine fresher and more food-friendly.

Producing Icewine is an extraordinarily laborious process, involving the thawing and freezing of grapes on numerous occasions, picking them at the perfect moment and, in the winery, a long, slow pressing during which the winery workers have been known to stage a few games of hockey to pass the time.

The wines that result – uniquely unctuous but with a piercing streak of lip-smacking freshness – are delicious on their own, but acquire new dimensions alongside food. A trait best showcased by Peller's in-house chef, Jason Parsons, aka 'the Willy Wonka of Icewine.'

Eye-widening dishes include suckling pig marinated in Icewine, candy floss jelly made with Icewine – and a 'blue ice dessert' which involves soaking a wheel of Québec blue cheese in six litres of Icewine for two weeks before serving. Wow.

Certified organic producers

There are many different organic accreditation bodies around the world. In order to gain accreditation, a producer has to demonstrate that they meet several criteria, the most important of which is not using artificial chemical fertilisers, pesticides, fungicides or herbicides in the vineyard. One of the key differences in legal definitions of organic winemaking in different countries is the legally permitted use of preservatives, such as sulphur.

Owned by the same family since 1705, Château La Gaffelière has belongs to the Malet Roquefort family for several generations. This property has the unique distinction of being one of the oldest, family-owned vineyards in the Saint-Émilion appellation of Bordeaux. The family can trace their roots in the Right Bank all the way back to the 1400s. With vines on the premium Saint-Émilion Grand Cru plateau close to Château Ausone and not far from Château Bélair-Monange, this 22-hectare property classified as a Premier Grand Cru Classé is located in the centre of the Saint-Émilion appellation benefiting from a more continental climate compared to the maritime Médoc. La Gaffelière vineyards (Cabernet Sauvignon 5%, Merlot 65%, Cabernet Franc 30%) lie on a sloped sandy/clay-limestone topsoil and limestone subsoil. The family also produces Dame Gaffelière (Second Wine) from their younger vines and Château l'Eglise D'Armens (Third Wine) a more approachable Saint-Émilion Grand Cru.

The best way to find new gems in the Rhône Valley is to ask people in the region what they like to drink, and we were gladly given the name of Cécile Dusserre at Domaine de Montvac. 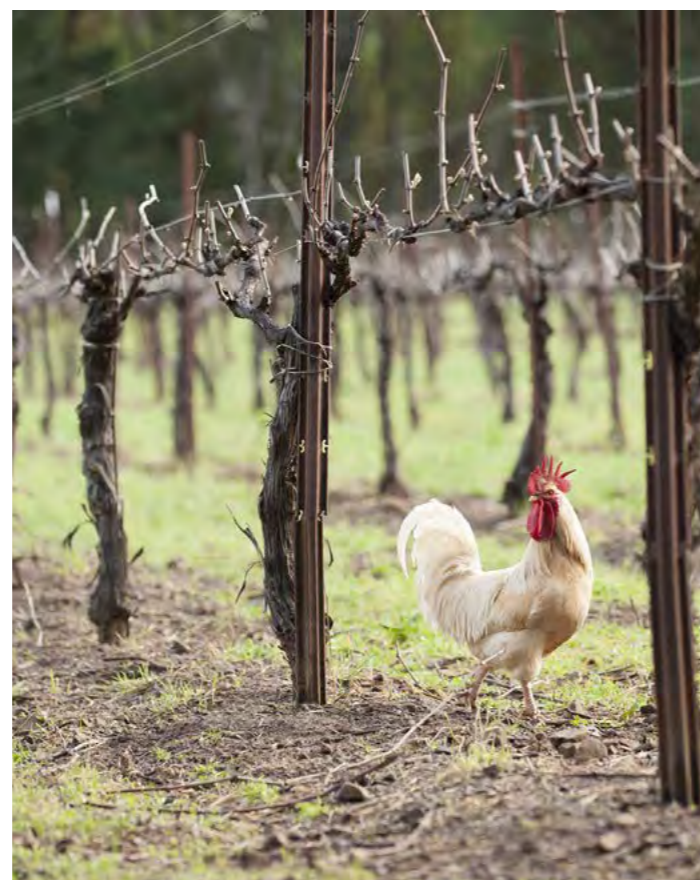
Biodynamic producers

Michael Seresin, born and educated in Wellington, left New Zealand for Europe in his early twenties to pursue a career as a cinematographer. Returning in 1992, Michael founded Seresin Estate in the maritime province of Marlborough. A “New World winery with an Old World approach,” Seresin offers elegant expressions of Pinot Noir, feisty Sauvignon Blanc and graceful Chardonnay. The vineyard has been farmed organically from the start with biodynamic principles introduced soon after.

HOW IS SERESIN JOURNEYING TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY?

When vines require irrigation, this is run on long cycles which helps the water penetrate deeper into the soil. This encourages the vines to grow their roots deeper into the soil, making them less reliant on water available at the soil’s surface. From 2021, all wines are bottled in lightweight glass weighing 417g (the lightest glass currently available in New Zealand), which has reduced their annual glass use by 10%.

This means that a producer who is certified biodynamic has implicitly already earned organic certification. The broken crags of Les Dentelles de Montmirail form a dramatic, gap-toothed backdrop to some of the finest vineyards of Gigondas. Steeply terraced, low-yielding and back-breaking to work, they simply wouldn't be worth cultivating if they didn't produce great wine. Thankfully, in cuvées such as Laurent Brusset's Le Grand Montmirail and Les Hauts de Montmirail, these south-facing terraces prove all that trouble worthwhile. The presence of a decent amount of Mourvèdre in the Brusset vineyards also gives an understated power and backbone that goes beyond typical Gigondas.

Over Christmas of 1980, a Swiss family called the Widmers travelled to Tuscany and fell in love with a beautiful estate owned by an elderly English gentleman who was looking to sell. Incorporating what was historically two estates called Brancaia and Poppi, it is in the heart of Chianti Classico. The Widmers moved quickly and soon won their first award for the 1983 Chianti Classico. Their daughter, Barbara Widmer, took over as winemaker in 1998. This is also the year in which the Widmers acquire the Maremma estate, which is released as the Ilatraia in 2002, scoring 95 points in Wine International. Their top wine, Il Blu, quickly became a classic for Super-Tuscan fans around the world.
